

Membership Committee Report CABF AGM 2022

On September 23, 2022, the membership of CABF was one (1) life member and fifty-five (55) individual members. Donations from five (5) member churches have been received so far in 2022. The Membership Committee received two (2) applications for individual membership since January 1, 2022. In the 2021 fiscal year, there were two (2) life members, fifty (50) individual members and donations were received from nine (9) member churches. Individual members may participate and vote at regular and special business meetings and also receive *The Bulletin* directly by mail. Member churches may appoint delegates with voting privileges at regular and special business meetings and receive bulk mailings of *The Bulletin*. A number of individual members have chosen to renew their membership and make donations by e-transfer directly to the CABF bank account. E-transfers can be sent to cabftreasurer@gmail.com. Council also added another payment option for membership payments, donations and event registrations. This can now be done using the CABF website credit card option.

At the January 5th meeting of Council a motion was approved to change the method for determining annual individual memberships. Individual memberships will now be for a period of twelve (12) consecutive months instead of the calendar year. Therefore, the annual membership fee going forward is payable one year following your last payment date and will expire one year later. This will allow members to pay forward their annual membership for more than one year, if they wish.
